	The Healthy Choices: Food and Drink Guideline promotes the health of MBPH employees, visitors, contractors and volunteers through increased availability of healthy food and drinks and decreased availability of less nutritious food and drinks, via retail food outlets, vending machines and official catering practices.		
	This guideline does not apply to food and drinks provided to inpatients and of MBPH facilities.

1.0 Healthy Choices Policy Directive	MBPH will support healthy eating by implementing the Victorian Government's Healthy choices: Policy directive for Victorian public health services. The Policy directive states that foods and drinks available to staff, visitors and volunteers must be in line with the <i>Healthy choices: food and drinks classification guide</i> , which classifies foods and drinks according to their nutritional value: - GREEN (best choices),	
	- AMBER (choose carefully) or - RED (limit).	
2.0 Contracts, tenders and leases	MBPH will include a requirement to meet the Policy directive in tenders, contracts and leases with relevant food and drink suppliers (Café 34; Work Health and Safety and Oasis Vending).	
	For Café 34 and all vending machines on MBPH campus:	
3.0 Food	 at least 50 per cent of food available and displayed is GREEN no more than 20 per cent of food available and displayed 	
	is RED - RED foods are not promoted or advertised.	
	For Café 34 and all vending machines on MBPH campus:	
4.0 Drinks	 no sugary (or RED category) drinks are available or promoted/advertised at least 50 per cent of drinks available and displayed are GREEN no more than 20 per cent of drinks available and displayed are AMBER artificially sweetened. 	
	Catering by MBPH Food Services:	
	 provide at least 50 per cent GREEN food options and no RED food for workplace catering, functions, and events. supply no sugary (or RED category) drinks for workplace catering, functions, and events. 	
5.0 Catering	Catering for special occasions:	
	 Whilst RED food and drink options should be avoided wherever possible, small amounts of RED foods or drinks, such as alcohol, may be provided via catering for occasional and defined events and with prior approval of the Chief Executive Officer (CEO),
